| 23 | confidential and exempt from s. 119.07(1) and s. 24(a), Art. I |

| 44 | Section 2. The Legislature finds that it is a public |
| 45 | necessity that information relating to communications services |
| 46 | locations, project proposals, and challenges submitted to and |
| 47 | held by the Department of Economic Opportunity under s. |
| 48 | 288.9962, Florida Statutes, be made exempt from s. 119.07(1), |
| 49 | Florida Statutes, and s. 24(a), Article I of the State |
| 50 | Constitution if such information is not otherwise publicly |
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| 51 | available and would reveal the location and capacity of |
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| 52 | communications network facilities; communications network |
| 53 | coverage areas, including geographical maps indicating actual or |
| 54 | proposed locations of network infrastructure, facilities, or |
| 55 | coverage; the features, functions, and capabilities of |
| 56 | communications network infrastructure and facilities; security, |
| 57 | including cybersecurity, of the design, construction, and |
| 58 | operation of the communications network and associated services |
| 59 | and products; specific customer locations; or sources of funding |
| 60 | or in-kind contributions for a project. Such information |
| 61 | contains security information and proprietary business |
| 62 | information of communications services providers. The disclosure |
| 63 | of sensitive information relating to the locations, capacities, |
| 64 | features, and functions of communications networks and |
| 65 | facilities could result in identification of vulnerabilities in |
| 66 | such networks and facilities and allow security breaches that |
| 67 | may damage and disrupt the safe and reliable operation of such |
| 68 | networks, adversely impacting the public health and safety of |
| 69 | the state. Disclosure of such information would adversely affect |
| 70 | the business interests and compromise the network security of |
| 71 | such communications services providers and their networks and |
| 72 | facilities. |
| 73 | Section 3. This act shall take effect July 1, 2023. |
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
