Remove lines 137-157 and insert:

(10) (a) A covered entity that is required to obtain a license to operate in the state shall submit documentation regarding compliance with subsections (4) and (5), as applicable, upon initial application for such license or on first renewal after July 1, 2023.

(b) A covered entity that fails to comply with subsection (4) or subsection (5) shall be subject to penalties under paragraph (c) and is subject to licensure or regulatory disciplinary action, as applicable.
