The grants may be used to increase 24 security and safety, including, but not limited to: 25 (a) The purchase and installation of security

27	camera systems, perimeter fencing, barriers and bollards, blast
28	resistant film, and shatter resistant glass for windows.
29	(b) Hiring security personnel.
30	(c) Training for security personnel and staff on threat
31	awareness, emergency procedures, and first aid.
32	(2) The minimum amount of any grant award is \$10,000, and
33	the maximum grant award amount is \$150,000. The total amount of
34	funds available for the program is limited to the amount
35	appropriated by the Legislature.
36	(3) The division may use up to 3 percent of the total
37	amount appropriated to administer the grant program.
38	(4) The division shall adopt rules to administer this
39	section.
40	(5) This section expires January 1, 2028, unless reviewed
41	and saved from repeal through reenactment by the Legislature.

Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2023.
