(1)(a) Except as provided in subsections (3), (4), and (5), a person who knowingly and willfully transports into this state an individual whom who the person knows, or reasonably should know, has entered is illegally entering the United States in violation of law and has not been inspected by the Federal Government since his or her unlawful entry from another country commits a felony of the third degree, punishable as provided in

A naturalized United States citizen; 16 2.
