However, a law enforcement agency may not forcibly extract a DNA sample from such a person, and he or she may not be charged with a criminal offense for refusing to submit a DNA sample.

(7) COLLECTION OF DNA SAMPLES FROM OFFENDERS.-



(f) A law enforcement agency having custody of a person who becomes a qualifying offender solely because of the issuance of an immigration detainer by a federal immigration agency may request that a DNA sample be taken from the qualifying offender immediately after the agency receives the detainer and may secure and transmit the sample to the department in a timely manner. However, a law enforcement agency may not forcibly extract such a DNA sample, and the qualifying offender may not be charged with a criminal offense for refusing to submit a DNA sample.
