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no case shall such action be brought more than 4 years after the date the appraisal services or appraisal management services were performed, or should have been performed.

- (3) An action to recover damages against an appraiser or appraisal management company for an act or omission in the performance of appraisal services or appraisal management services that occurred prior to July 1, 2023, shall, in all events, be brought on or before July 1, 2024.
- (4) Notwithstanding any other law to the contrary, all actions for damages or other relief brought against an appraiser or appraisal management company with respect to appraisal services or appraisal management services shall be governed exclusively by the provisions of this section.
- (5) This section does not apply to any administrative proceedings initiated by the board or department.
- (6) This section does not apply to any action in which it is alleged that an appraiser or appraisal management company committed fraud.
  - Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2023.
