Section 689.302, Florida Statutes, is created 12 13 to read: 689.302 Disclosure of flood risks to prospective 14 purchaser.—A seller of residential or commercial property shall, 15 16 before executing a contract for sale, disclose in writing to a 17 prospective purchaser all of the following information that is 18 known to the seller: 19 The property has suffered water damage or moisture-20 related damage caused by a natural flood event within the last 21 10 years. 22 (2) The property owner has maintained flood insurance. 23 (3) Any portion of the property is located in or near a 24 designated flood hazard zone established by the Federal 25 Emergency Management Agency.
