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Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

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Section 1. Subsection (3) of section 1003.25, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

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1003.25 Procedures for maintenance and transfer of student records.—

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(3) (a) 1. Procedures relating to the acceptance of transfer work, grades, and credit for students shall be prescribed by rule by the State Board of Education. Credits and grades for a student who transfers to a public school in the state shall be accepted at face value if such credits and grades are submitted

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on an official transcript.

- 2. If the transfer of a student's grades or credits is denied, the school district must notify the student and his or her parent within 10 days after the denial. The student and his or her parent may appeal the denial with the State Board of Education within 10 days after receiving the notification from the school district. The student and his or her parent may provide written or verbal evidence to the State Board of Education, and the state board shall grant or deny the appeal at its next regularly scheduled meeting.
- (b) Each district school board shall, at a regular meeting, establish a policy that explains the process and standards established by State Board of Education rules for the transfer and acceptance or denial of grades and credits. Such policy must clearly state the requirements and limitations for the acceptance or denial of a student's grades or credits.
- (c) The State Board of Education shall collect and annually publish on its website each district school board's policy required under paragraph (b).
 - Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2023.
