Section 403.7034, Florida Statutes, is created 17 to read: 18 403.7034 Coastal community pilot program to regulate 19 single-use plastic products.-20 (1) As used in this section, the term "coastal community" 21 means a municipality with a population of less than 500,000 that 22 abuts or borders the Gulf of Mexico; the Atlantic Ocean; or a 23 saltwater bay, sound, strait, inlet, lagoon, salt marsh, coastal 24 wetland, or other saltwater body immediately adjacent to the 25 Gulf of Mexico or the Atlantic Ocean.

26 (2) Notwithstanding s. 403.7033, a coastal community may 27 establish a pilot program to regulate single-use plastic 28 products. 29 (3) To establish a pilot program to regulate single-use 30 plastic products, a coastal community must: (a) Adopt an ordinance to regulate single-use plastic 31 32 products within the community's jurisdiction. The ordinance must take effect on or after July 1, 2024, and must expire by June 33 34 30, 2026. 51 recyclable materials is crucial to the ongoing welfare of 52 Florida's ecology and economy. As such, the Department of 53 Environmental Protection shall review and update its 2010 report 54 on retail bags analyzing the need for new or different 55 regulation of auxiliary containers, wrappings, or disposable 56 plastic bags used by consumers to carry products from retail 57 establishments. The updated report must include input from state 58 and local government agencies, stakeholders, private businesses, 59 and citizens and must evaluate the efficacy and necessity of both statewide and local regulation of these materials. To 60 ensure consistent and effective implementation, beginning in 61 2027, and every 5 years thereafter, the department shall submit 62 the updated report with conclusions and recommendations to the 63 64 Legislature no later than December 31_{7} - 2021. Until such time 65 that the Legislature adopts the recommendations of the 66 department, a local government, local governmental agency, or state governmental agency may not enact any rule, regulation, or 67 68 ordinance regarding use, disposition, sale, prohibition, 69 restriction, or tax of such auxiliary containers, wrappings, or 70 disposable plastic bags.
