10 (8)(a) An initiative or referendum process in regard to
11 any development order is prohibited.

12 (b) An initiative or referendum process in regard to any
13 land development regulation is prohibited.

14 (c)~~(b)~~ An initiative or referendum process in regard to
15 any local comprehensive plan amendment or map amendment is
16 prohibited unless it is expressly authorized by specific

17 language in a local government charter that was lawful and in
18 effect on June 1, 2011. A general local government charter
19 provision for an initiative or referendum process is not
20 sufficient.

21 ~~(d)(e)~~ It is the intent of the Legislature that initiative
22 and referendum be prohibited in regard to any development order
23 or any land development regulation. It is the intent of the
24 Legislature that initiative and referendum be prohibited in
25 regard to any local comprehensive plan amendment or map
26 amendment, except as specifically and narrowly allowed by
27 paragraph (b). Therefore, the prohibition on initiative and
28 referendum stated in paragraphs (a) and (b) is remedial in
29 nature and applies retroactively to any initiative or referendum
30 process commenced after June 1, 2011, and any such initiative or
31 referendum process commenced or completed thereafter is deemed
32 null and void and of no legal force and effect.

33 Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2023.
