(a) 23 (b) Must be based on a curriculum developed or procured by 24 the Department of Education, including instructional materials. 25 (C) May be integrated into existing curriculum or courses.

32	subfund within the Opioid Settlement Clearing Trust Fund
33	established in s. 17.42.
