26 an assignment agreement under a motor vehicle insurance policy 27 issued on or after July 1, 2023. Any attempt by a policyowner to 28 enter into such assignment agreement is void and unenforceable. 29 As used in this subsection, the term: 30 "Assignment agreement" means any instrument, (a) regardless of how named or styled, by which post-loss benefits, 31 32 including claim payments, under a motor vehicle insurance policy 33 are, in whole or in part, assigned or transferred to, or 34 acquired in any manner by, a person providing services, 35 including, but not limited to, inspecting, protecting, 36 repairing, restoring, or replacing the motor vehicle or 37 mitigating against further damage to the motor vehicle. "Motor vehicle insurance policy" means a policy that 38 (b) 39 provides personal injury protection coverage, property damage 40 liability coverage, or both. 41 Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2023.
