Remove lines 287-293 and insert:

7 (1) (a) A person is authorized to carry a concealed weapon
 8 or concealed firearm, as that term is defined in s. 790.06(1),
 9 if he or she is licensed under s. 790.06; or

10 (b) Is not licensed under s. 790.06, but otherwise
 11 satisfies the criteria for receiving and maintaining such a
 12 license under s. 790.06(2) (a)-(f) and (i)-(n), (3), and (10) and
 13 compiles with each of the following:

14 1. Has completed a firearms safety class and passed a
 15 written exam administered by the Department of Agriculture and
 16 Consumer Services.

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17 2. Has a written statement from a physician licensed under
18 chapter 458 or chapter 459 certifying that the individual is
19 mentally fit and does not have a history of drug abuse; or

20 3. Has passed a mental health evaluation and drug
21 screening administered by the Department of Agriculture and
22 Consumer Services.

23 4. Has taken a 1-day training class in firearms use and
24 passed a live firing test devised by the Department of
25 Agriculture and Consumer Services, with at least 90 percent
26 accuracy.

27 5. Has a safe place or container to store all firearms and
28 an ammunition locker that meets safety regulations, all of which
29 must be inspected by a law enforcement officer.

30 6. Has been fingerprinted and passed a criminal background
31 screening administered by the Department of Agriculture and
32 Consumer Services, which specifically included a background
33 check identifying any involvement in domestic violence, or any
34 other physical violence towards self or others.
