Any voter elector 15 may designate in writing a person to pick up the ballot for the 16 voter elector; however, the person designated may not pick up more than two vote-by-mail ballots per election, other than the 17 18 designee's own ballot, except that additional ballots may be 19 picked up for members of the designee's immediate family. For 20 purposes of this section, "immediate family" means the 21 designee's spouse or the parent, child, grandparent, grandchild, 22 or sibling of the designee or of the designee's spouse. The 23 designee shall provide to the supervisor the written 24 authorization by the voter elector and a picture identification 25 of the designee and must complete an affidavit. The designee 26 shall state in the affidavit that the designee is authorized by 27 the voter <del>elector</del> to pick up that ballot and shall indicate if 28 the voter elector is a member of the designee's immediate family 29 and, if so, the relationship. The department shall prescribe the 30 form of the affidavit. If the supervisor is satisfied that the 31 designee is authorized to pick up the ballot and that the 32 signature of the voter elector on the written authorization 33 matches the signature of the voter elector on file, the 34 supervisor must shall give the ballot to that designee for 35 delivery to the voter <del>elector</del>.
