8 (c) Before the commencement of any action for damages
9 under this section for text message solicitations, the called
10 party must notify the telephone solicitor that the called party
11 does not wish to receive text messages from the telephone
12 solicitor by replying "STOP" to the number from which the called
13 party received text messages from the telephone solicitor.
14 Within 15 days after receipt of such notice, the telephone
15 solicitor shall cease sending text message solicitations to the
16 called party and may not send text messages to the called party

17 thereafter, except that the telephone solicitor may send the
18 called party a text message to confirm receipt of the notice.
19 The called party may bring an action under this section only if
20 the called party does not consent to receive text messages from
21 the telephone solicitor and the telephone solicitor continues to

23 party provided notice to the telephone solicitor to cease such
24 text messages.
