House Resolution 1 2 A resolution designating February 2023 as "VATER 3 Syndrome Awareness Month" in Florida. 4 5 WHEREAS, the health and well-being of all Floridians 6 contributes greatly to the prosperity and livelihood of our 7 state's families and communities, and 8 WHEREAS, VATER syndrome, also known as VACTERL association, 9 refers to several different birth defects that frequently occur in conjunction with each other, specifically vertebral 10 abnormalities, anal atresia, cardiac malformations, 11 tracheoesophageal fistula, renal abnormalities, and limb 12 13 abnormalities, causing devastating damage to the people who are afflicted with the disease, yet the syndrome is not well-known 14 15 outside of those impacted, and 16 WHEREAS, up to 80 percent of those with VATER syndrome are 17 impacted by cardiac defects, and up to 70 percent have limb 18 defects, and 19 WHEREAS, since babies born with VATER syndrome exhibit a 20 wide variety of symptoms, it is difficult to pinpoint exactly 21 how many individuals are impacted, and only a broad estimate of 22 between 1 in 10,000 to 40,000 people with the syndrome can be 23 made, and

24 WHEREAS, doctors and hospitals in Florida diagnose and 25 treat VATER syndrome, NOW, THEREFORE,
