1 House Resolution 2 A resolution designating April 16, 2023, as "Wolf-3 Hirschhorn/4p- Syndrome Awareness Day." 4 5 WHEREAS, the health and well-being of all Floridians 6 contributes greatly to the prosperity and livelihood of our 7 state's families and communities, and 8 WHEREAS, Wolf-Hirschhorn syndrome, also known as 4p-9 syndrome, is a chromosomal disorder caused by a partial deletion of the short arm of chromosome 4, and 10 11 WHEREAS, children with 4p- syndrome are usually born with low birth weight and develop slowly, both cognitively and 12 13 physically, compared to their same-age peers, and experience 14 medical complications while still trying to maintain a normal childhood, and 15 16 WHEREAS, medical professionals are presently researching this rare disease, its misdiagnosis, and the exploration of new 17 18 therapies and diagnostic tools to help individuals with 4p-19 syndrome and their families, and 20 WHEREAS, 4p- syndrome affects an estimated 1 in 50,000 21 births, which may be an underestimate because some affected 22 individuals may go undiagnosed, and 23 WHEREAS, effective diagnostic screenings, early 24 intervention, treatments, and families and advocates can increase knowledge and awareness of 4p- syndrome, and 25 Page 1 of 2
