21	Holocaust Remembrance Day shall be observed in the schools on								
22	the preceding school day or on such school day as may be								
23	designated by local school authorities.								
24	(3) Instruction about the Holocaust, anti-Semitism, and								
25	their harmful impacts on humanity shall be provided as part of
