Remove lines 26-52 and insert:

7 electronically any records that are required or authorized to be
 8 filed with it pursuant to chapter 48, chapter 55, chapter 117,
 9 chapter 118, chapter 495, chapter 605, chapter 606, chapter 607,
 10 chapter 610, chapter 617, chapter 620, chapter 621, chapter 679,
 11 chapter 713, or chapter 865, through facsimile or other
 12 electronic transfers, for the purpose of filing such records.

13 The department may implement a password protected system for the
 14 filing of such records. A person using the password protected
 15 system to electronically file a record may be required to verify
 16 his or her credentials and provide supplemental materials to the

17 department, including his or her original signature. The
18 department may allow an entity organized under a chapter
19 specified in this subsection to identify authorized account
20 holders for the purpose of electronically filing records related
21 to the entity. The department shall use the e-mail address on
22 file with the Division of Corporations on January 1, 2024, as
23 the initial authorized account holder and shall send to that e-
24 mail address a code providing access to the password protected
25 system. The department may require verification of the identity
26 of an authorized account holder before such account holder may
27 file a record with the department through the password protected
28 system. The originals of all such electronically transmitted
29 records must be executed in the manner provided in paragraph
30 (5) (b). The receipt of such electronic transfer constitutes
31 delivery to the department as required by law. The department
32 may use electronic transmissions for purposes of notice in the
33 administration of chapters 48, 55, 117, 118, 495, 605, 606, 607,
