13	Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

15	Section 1. Subsection (5) is added to section 119.0712,
16	Florida Statutes, to read:
17	119.0712 Executive branch agency-specific exemptions from
18	inspection or copying of public records
19	(5) DEPARTMENT OF STATE.—
20	(a) E-mail addresses collected and held by the Department
21	of State pursuant to chapter 48, chapter 55, chapter 117,
22	<u>chapter 118, chapter 495, chapter 605, chapter 606, chapter 607,</u>
23	<u>chapter 610, chapter 617, chapter 620, chapter 621, chapter 679,</u>
24	chapter 713, or chapter 865 are exempt from s. 119.07(1) and s.
25	24(a), Art. I of the State Constitution. This exemption applies
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26	to e-mail addresses held by the department before, on, or after
27	the effective date of this act.
28	(b) Secure login credentials held by the Department of
29	State for purposes of a password protected system implemented
30	pursuant to s. 15.16(3) are exempt from s. 119.07(1) and s.
31	24(a), Art. I of the State Constitution. This exemption applies
32	to secure login credentials held by the department before, on,
33	or after the effective date of the exemption. For purposes of
34	this paragraph, the term "secure login credentials" means
35	information held by the department for purposes of
36	authenticating a user logging into a user account on a computer,
37	a computer system, a computer network, or an electronic device;
38	an online user account accessible over the Internet, whether
39	through a mobile device, a website, or any other electronic
40	means; or information used for authentication or password
41	recovery.
42	(c) This subsection is subject to the Open Government
43	Sunset Review Act in accordance with s. 119.15 and shall stand
44	repealed on October 2, 2028, unless reviewed and saved from
45	repeal through reenactment by the Legislature.
46	Section 2. The Legislature finds that it is a public
47	necessity that e-mail addresses collected and held by the
48	Department of State and secure login credentials held by the
49	Department of State for purposes of a password protected system
50	implemented pursuant to s. 15.16(3), Florida Statutes, be made
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51	exempt from s. 119.07(1), Florida Statutes, and s. 24(a),
52	Article I of the State Constitution. Such identifying
53	information can be used as a tool to perpetuate fraud against an
54	individual or corporation, the release of which could cause
55	great financial harm to the individual or corporation.
56	Therefore, the Legislature finds that it is a public necessity
57	that such information be made exempt from public records
58	requirements.
59	Section 3. This act shall take effect on the same date
60	that HB 909 or similar legislation takes effect, if such
61	legislation is adopted in the same legislative session or an
62	extension thereof and becomes a law.

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
