- Section 1. Subsection (2) and paragraph (a) of subsection (3) of section 218.077, Florida Statutes, are amended to read:

 218.077 Wage and employment benefits requirements by political subdivisions; restrictions.—
- (2) Except as otherwise provided in subsection (3), a political subdivision may not establish, mandate, maintain, or otherwise require an employer to pay a minimum wage, other than a state or federal minimum wage, to apply a state or federal minimum wage to wages exempt from a state or federal minimum wage, or to provide employment benefits not otherwise required by state or federal law. No political subdivision may through

its purchasing or contracting procedures seek to control or
affect the wages or employment benefits provided by its vendors,
contractors, service providers, or other parties doing business
with the political subdivision. A political subdivision shall
not through the use of evaluation factors, qualification of

employment benefits provided by its vendors, contractors,
service providers, or other parties doing business with the
political subdivision.

- (3) This section does not:
- (a) Limit the authority of a political subdivision to establish a minimum wage other than a state or federal minimum wage or to provide employment benefits not otherwise required under state or federal law:
 - 1. For the employees of the political subdivision; or
- 2. For the employees of an employer contracting to provide goods or services for the political subdivision, or for the employees of a subcontractor of such an employer, under the terms of a contract with the political subdivision; or
- 3. For the employees of an employer receiving a direct tax abatement or subsidy from the political subdivision, as a condition of the direct tax abatement or subsidy.
