25	whose conditions are still not known, and
26	WHEREAS, more Jewish civilian lives were lost on October 7,
27	2023, than any single day since 1945, and
28	WHEREAS, the attack on October 7, 2023, was reminiscent of
29	other instances when Jewish people have been persecuted
