- (2) (a) A governmental entity may not erect or display a flag that represents a political viewpoint, including, but not limited to, a politically partisan, racial, sexual orientation and gender, or political ideology viewpoint. The governmental entity must remain neutral when representing political viewpoints in displaying or erecting a flag.
  - (b) This subsection does not limit the ability of:
- 1. A private individual to express private speech or viewpoints or exercise rights protected by the First Amendment to the United States Constitution.
- 2. A governmental entity to display or erect a flag required or authorized by general law.
- (3) A governmental entity that displays the United States flag must display the United States flag in a prominent position that is superior to any other flag that is also displayed.
  - (4) A veteran may, at any time, use reasonable force to
