Remove everything after the enacting clause and insert: Section 1. Section 318.195, Florida Statutes, is created to read:

- 318.195 Enhanced penalties for moving violations causing injury or death to vulnerable road users.—
- (1) This section may be cited as the "Vulnerable Road User Act."
- (2) A person who commits a moving violation that causes serious bodily injury to a vulnerable road user shall pay a fine of not less than \$1,500 and attend a department approved driver improvement course relating to the rights of vulnerable road

The department shall also revoke the person's driver license for 1 year.
- (4) As used in this section, the terms "serious bodily injury" and "vulnerable road user" have the same meaning as in s. 316.027(1).
- (5) This section does not prohibit a person from being charged with, convicted of, or punished for any other violation of law.
