Section 1. Subsection (13) of section 790.065, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

790.065 Sale and delivery of firearms.—

(13) A person younger than 21 years of age may not purchase a firearm. The sale or transfer of a firearm to a person younger than 21 years of age may not be made or facilitated by any person ~~a licensed importer, licensed manufacturer, or licensed dealer~~. A person who violates this subsection commits a felony of the third degree, punishable as

 15 prohibitions of this subsection do not apply to the purchase of
 16 a rifle or shotgun by a law enforcement officer or correctional
