A bill to be entitled

An act relating to graduate medical education program performance data; amending s. 409.909, F.S.; requiring the Agency for Health Care Administration, by a specified date, to develop and implement a methodology for collecting performance data from graduate medical education programs seeking or receiving public funding under the Statewide Medicaid Residency Program; specifying minimum requirements for the performance data; requiring the agency to establish certain minimum performance measurements for graduate medical programs receiving funding under the program; providing that, beginning on a specified date, such performance measurements are a condition for receiving funding under the program; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Present subsections (7) and (8) of section 409.909, Florida Statutes, are redesignated as subsections (8) and (9), respectively, and a new subsection (7) is added to that section, to read:

409.909 Statewide Medicaid Residency Program.-

implement a methodology for collecting performance data from graduate medical education programs seeking or receiving funding under this section. At a minimum, the performance data collected must include measurable efforts by a graduate medical education

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program to increase the availability of residents to serve rural and underserved communities in this state. Based on the data collected pursuant to this subsection, the agency shall establish minimum performance measurements that, beginning July 1, 2025, must be met by graduate medical education programs as a condition to receive funding under this section.

Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2024.
