6 Remove lines 600-605 and insert:

7 Section 3. (1) For the 2023-2024 fiscal year, the sum of
 8 \$250,000 in nonrecurring funds from the General Revenue Fund is
 9 appropriated to the Department of Health to implement and
 10 administer the Health Care Innovation Council under s. 381.4015,
 11 Florida Statutes.

12 (2) For the 2024-2025 fiscal year, the recurring sum of \$1
 13 million is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to the
 14 Department of Health to implement and administer the Health Care
 15 Innovation Council under s. 381.4015, Florida Statutes.

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16 (3) By August 1 of each year, beginning in the 2024-2025
17 fiscal year through the 2033-2034 fiscal year, the Chief
18 Financial Officer shall transfer \$50 million in nonrecurring
19 funds from the General Revenue Fund to the Grants and Donations
20 Trust Fund within the Department of Health. Each year, beginning
21 in the 2024-2025 fiscal year through the 2033-2034 fiscal year,
22 the nonrecurring sum of \$50 million is appropriated from the
23 Grants and Donations Trust Fund to the Department of Health for
24 the revolving loan fund created in s. 381.4015, Florida
25 Statutes. The department may use up to 3 percent of the
26 appropriated funds for administrative costs to implement the
27 revolving loan program.
