- (10) A person whose driver license is suspended under subsection (1) or subsection (3) may apply for issuance of a license for business or employment purposes only if the person is otherwise eligible for the driving privilege pursuant to s. 322.271.
 - (a) If the suspension of the driver license of the person



12 for failure to submit to a breath, urine, or blood test is 13 sustained, the person is not eligible to receive a license for 14 business or employment purposes only, pursuant to s. 322.271, 15 until 90 days have elapsed after the expiration of the last 16 temporary permit issued and the person must continue placement 17 of the ignition interlock device as required by s. 316.1939 for 18 an additional 3 months.
