Senator Pizzo moved the following: Senate Amendment (with title amendment) 1 3 Delete everything after the enacting clause 4 and insert: 5 Section 1. Subsection (7) is added to section 487.081, 6 Florida Statutes, to read: 7 487.081 Exemptions.-(7) (a) A products liability action, including a failure to 9 warn, may not be brought or maintained against an applicator of 10 pesticides unless: 1. The applicator exercised substantial control over an 11

12 aspect of the design, testing, manufacture, or labeling of the 13 product alleged to have caused the harm for which recovery of 14 damages is sought;

2. The applicator altered or modified the product, and the alteration or modification was a legal cause of the alleged harm for which recovery of damages is sought;

3. The applicator handled, used, or applied the product in a manner inconsistent with the product label, and such action or failure to warn was a legal cause of the alleged harm for which recovery of damages is sought;

4. The applicator engaged in some other negligent act relating to the pesticide, and such negligence was a legal cause of the alleged harm for which the recovery of damages is sought;

5. The manufacturer of the product alleged to have caused the harm for which recovery of damages is sought is not subject to personal jurisdiction in this state; or

6. The manufacturer of the product alleged to have caused 29 the harm for which recovery of damages is sought is located in 30 or is incorporated in, or the product is manufactured in, a 31 foreign country of concern as defined in s. 288.860, including 32 the People's Republic of China, the Russian Federation, the 33 Islamic Republic of Iran, the Democratic People's Republic of Korea, the Republic of Cuba, the Venezuelan regime of Nicolás 35 Maduro, or the Syrian Arab Republic, including any agency of or any other entity under significant control of such foreign country of concern. (b) This subsection applies only to pesticides as defined 39 in s. 487.021.
