26 (2)(1) A person or entity that offers for resale or 27 resells any ticket may charge only \$1 above the admission price 28 charged therefor by the original ticket seller of the ticket for 29 the following transactions:

30 The following information must be prominently (d) displayed on the homepage or ticket landing page before the 31 purchase of any tickets, other than the tickets described in 32 33 paragraph (a), paragraph (b), or paragraph (c), that are resold 34 or offered through an Internet website, unless such website is authorized by the original ticket seller or makes and posts the 35 36 following guarantees and disclosures through Internet web pages 37 on which are visibly posted, or links to web pages on which are 38 posted, text to which a prospective purchaser is directed before 39 completion of the resale transaction:

1. The website operator guarantees a full refund of the amount paid for the ticket including any servicing, handling, or processing fees, if such fees are not disclosed, when:

a. The ticketed event is canceled;

44 b. The purchaser is denied admission to the ticketed 45 event, unless such denial is due to the action or omission of 46 the purchaser;
