Remove everything after the enacting clause and insert:

Section 1. Collective bargaining issues at impasse for the 2024-2025 fiscal year between the State of Florida and the certified representatives of the bargaining units for state employees are resolved as follows:

(1) Collective bargaining issues at impasse between the State of Florida and the Florida State Fire Association - Fire Service Bargaining Unit, regarding Article 29 "Health and Welfare," are resolved by adopting the state's proposals dated January 5, 2024.

14 (2) All other mandatory collective bargaining issues at
 15 impasse for the 2024-2025 fiscal year which are not addressed by
 16 this act or the General Appropriations Act for the 2024-2025
 17 fiscal year shall be resolved in accordance with the personnel
 18 rules in effect on March 5, 2024, and by otherwise maintaining
 19 the status quo under the language of the applicable current
 20 collective bargaining agreement.

21 Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2024.
