Section 1. Present subsections (5) and (6) of section 408.051, Florida Statutes, are redesignated as subsections (6) and (7), respectively, and a new subsection (5) is added to that section, to read:

- (a) Hospitals may maintain national network connectivity directly or through a third-party vendor.
- (b) Hospitals with 25 or fewer beds are exempt from this subsection.
- (c) The agency shall adopt rules necessary to implement this subsection.

Section 2. Subsections (5) and (6) are added to section 408.0611, Florida Statutes, to read:

408.0611 Electronic prescribing clearinghouse.-

- (5) Hospitals as defined in s. 395.002 which maintain certified electronic health record technology must make patient admission, transfer, and discharge data available to the agency's Florida Health Information Exchange program for the purpose of supporting public health data registries and patient care coordination.
- (6) Beginning January 1, 2025, a community pharmacy as defined in s. 465.003(20)(a)1. which maintains a system for electronic prescribing as defined in s. 408.0611(2) shall participate in the agency's Emergency Patient Look-Up System for the purpose of supporting emergency response during a declared state of emergency.
- (a) Internet pharmacies as defined in s. 465.003 are exempt from this subsection until their electronic prescribing vendor is connected to the agency's Emergency Patient Look-Up System.
 - (b) The agency shall adopt rules necessary to administer
