An applicant who is rated effective or highly effective, pursuant to s. 1012.34, for the entirety of the 10-year validity period of his or her professional certificate is eligible to renew a professional certificate valid for 10 years. An applicant issued a 10-year professional certificate who does not meet the requirement of this subparagraph is eligible only for renewal of a professional certificate valid for 5 years.

(b) A teacher with national certification from the National Board for Professional Teaching Standards is deemed to meet state renewal requirements for the life of the teacher's national certificate in the subject shown on the national certificate. A complete renewal application and fee shall be submitted. The Commissioner of Education shall notify teachers 27 of the renewal application and fee requirements.

28 (c) If the renewal application form is not received by the 29 department or by the employing school district before the 30 expiration of the professional certificate, the application 31 form, application fee, and a late fee must be submitted before July 1 of the year following expiration of the certificate in 33 order to renew the professional certificate.
