13 MISCELLANEOUS EXEMPTIONS. - Exemptions provided to any (7) 14 entity by this chapter do not inure to any transaction that is 15 otherwise taxable under this chapter when payment is made by a representative or employee of the entity by any means, 16 17 including, but not limited to, cash, check, or credit card, even when that representative or employee is subsequently reimbursed 18 19 by the entity. In addition, exemptions provided to any entity by this subsection do not inure to any transaction that is 20 21 otherwise taxable under this chapter unless the entity has obtained a sales tax exemption certificate from the department 22 or the entity obtains or provides other documentation as 23 24 required by the department. Eligible purchases or leases made 25 with such a certificate must be in strict compliance with this 26 subsection and departmental rules, and any person who makes an 27 exempt purchase with a certificate that is not in strict 28 compliance with this subsection and the rules is liable for and 29 shall pay the tax.
