The board, if seeking to construct or improve a public building, structure, or other public works, 31 32 shall comply with the bidding procedures of section 255.20, Florida Statutes, and other applicable general law., and In each 33 34 case, the bid of the lowest responsive and responsible bidder shall be accepted, unless all bids are rejected because the bids 35 36 are too high or the board determines it is in the best interests of the district to reject all bids. The board may require the 37 38 bidders to furnish bonds bond with a responsible surety to be 39 approved by the board. Nothing in this section shall prevent the board from undertaking and performing the construction, 40 41 operation, and maintenance of any project or facility authorized 42 by this act $_{\boldsymbol{\tau}}$ by the employment of labor, material, and 43 machinery.
