House Joint Resolution
A joint resolution proposing the creation of Section 33 of Article X of the State Constitution to prohibit the use of traffic infraction detectors within this state.

Be It Resolved by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

That the following creation of Section 33 of Article X of the State Constitution is agreed to and shall be submitted to the electors of this state for approval or rejection at the next general election or at an earlier special election specifically authorized by law for that purpose:

ARTICLE X
MISCELLANEOUS
SECTION 33. Use of traffic infraction detectors prohibited.-
(a) The use of traffic infraction detectors, also known as "red-light cameras," is prohibited within this state.
(b) For purposes of this section, the term "traffic infraction detector" or "red-light camera" means any system designed to work in conjunction with a traffic control signal to record any image or video of any portion of a motor vehicle at the time the vehicle fails to stop behind the stop bar or

clearly marked stop line when facing a traffic control signal steady red light.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the following statement be placed on the ballot:

CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT
ARTICLE 33, SECTION X
USE OF TRAFFIC INFRACTION DETECTORS PROHIBITED.-Proposing an amendment to the State Constitution to prohibit the use within this state of traffic infraction detectors, also known as "red-light cameras," which are used to record any image or video of any portion of a motor vehicle that fails to stop behind the clearly marked stop line when facing a steady red light.
