An act relating to governing body meetings; amending s. 166.0213, F.S.; authorizing governing bodies of municipalities to convene meetings and conduct official business via teleconferencing or other technological means if certain conditions are met; providing limitations on such meetings; providing that certain limitations placed on such meetings may be suspended by the Governor, for a specified timeframe, upon a declared state of emergency impacting the municipality in which the meeting would occur; providing an effective date.

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Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

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Section 1. Subsection (3) is added to section 166.0213, Florida Statutes, to read:

166.0213 Governing body meetings.-

- (3) (a) The governing body of a municipality may convene meetings and conduct official business via teleconferencing or other technological means as long as such meetings:
- 1. Meet all of the requirements for public notice, public access, and public participation.
- 2. Do not convene meetings via teleconferencing or other technological means more than two times per calendar year.
  - 3. Do not include formal action on ordinances.
  - 4. Are not a quasi-judicial hearing.
- (b) The limitations placed on meetings conducted via teleconferencing or other technological means under sub-
