and home inspection reports submitted before, on, or after the
effective date of this exemption.
(3) This section is subject to the Open Government Sunset
Review Act in accordance with s. 119.15 and shall stand repeale
on October 2, 2029, unless reviewed and saved from repeal

through reenactment by the Legislature.

Section 2. The Legislature finds that it is a public necessity that My Safe Florida Home Program applications and home inspection reports be made exempt from s. 119.07(1), Florida Statutes, and s. 24(a), Article I of the State Constitution. More than 99 percent of all home inspections and grant applications are completed electronically or by phone. Under current law, My Safe Florida Home Program applications and home inspection reports are public records and can be obtained by anyone for any purpose. These documents contain personal information, including, but not limited to, names, e-mail addresses, mailing addresses, and telephone numbers. This information is unique to each individual and, when combined with other personal identifying information, can be used for identity theft, consumer scams, unwanted solicitations, or other invasive contact. Additionally, the My Safe Florida Home Program applications and home inspection reports contain detailed descriptions and pictures of the inside and outside of applicants' homes, including private areas, points of entry, and

other vulnerabilities. The public availability of these records puts participants in the My Safe Florida Home Program at increased risk of home invasions and reduces privacy in their homes. Such risk may be significantly limited by making My Safe Florida Home Program applications and home inspection reports exempt from public record requirements.

Section 3. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law.
