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A bill to be entitled
An act relating to Medicaid coverage of continuous glucose monitors; requiring the Agency for Health Care Administration to, within a specified timeframe, seek federal approval as needed to provide coverage of continuous glucose monitors and related supplies as a durable medical equipment benefit under the Medicaid program; providing for the reimbursement of such equipment; providing construction; requiring the agency to implement these changes upon receiving any necessary federal approval; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. (1) Within 30 days after this act becomes a law, the Agency for Health Care Administration shall seek federal approval through a Medicaid waiver or state plan amendment as needed to provide coverage of continuous glucose monitors and related supplies as a durable medical equipment benefit for Medicaid recipients. A licensed durable medical equipment provider must be reimbursed for continuous glucose monitors and related supplies, provided the claim is submitted through an active Medicare Healthcare Common Procedure Coding System. The agency may not require such provider to use a National Drug Code number as part of such claim submission.

(2) This section does not preclude the agency from providing additional coverage of continuous glucose monitors as a Medicaid pharmacy benefit.

32 Section 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law.
