17	Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

19	Section 1. Section 1003.5717, Florida Statutes, is created
20	to read:
21	1003.5717 Workforce micro-credential program for students
22	with disabilities.—The Department of Education shall develop and
23	implement by January 31, 2026, a workforce micro-credential
24	program for students with disabilities that leverages existing
25	career and technical education curriculum frameworks. The
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26	purpose of the program is to signify to potential employers that
27	the students have demonstrated specific career ready practices
28	or career and technical education standards.
29	(1) Each course within a career and technical education
30	curriculum framework for students with disabilities must have at
31	least one associated micro-credential signifying that the
32	student has demonstrated at least five discrete specified career
33	ready practices or career and technical education standards,
34	including an understanding of workplace safety.
35	(a) The department shall work with the Florida Center for
36	Students with Unique Abilities established under s. 1004.6495
37	for the development and implementation of the workforce micro-
38	credential program and each micro-credential.
39	(b) The department shall collaborate with the Occupational
40	Safety and Health Administration to develop the specified career
41	ready practices or career and technical education standards
42	related to workplace safety.
43	(2) Upon completion of each such course, the student's
44	demonstration of the required career ready practices or career
45	and technical education standards must be validated by a member
46	of the instructional staff who specializes in exceptional
47	student education and a member of the student's individualized
48	education plan team prior to the award of the associated micro-
49	credential.
50	(3) Beginning with the 2026 calendar year through the 2030
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calendar year, the department shall prepare an annual report by
January 31 of the following year detailing the operations of the
program. At a minimum, the report must include the workforce
micro-credentials offered by the program, data on postgraduation
student employment, data on student participation rates in the
program, and any other outcome data deemed necessary by the
department to be included.
Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2025.

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
