



26 (1) TERMINATION AFTER GESTATIONAL AGE OF 6 WEEKS; WHEN  
27 ALLOWED.—A physician may not knowingly perform or induce a  
28 termination of pregnancy if the physician determines the  
29 gestational age of the fetus is more than 6 weeks unless one of  
30 the following conditions is met:

31 (a) A physician determines ~~Two physicians certify in~~  
32 ~~writing~~ that, in reasonable medical judgment, the termination of  
33 the pregnancy is necessary to save or prolong the pregnant  
34 woman's life or avert a serious risk of substantial ~~and~~  
35 ~~irreversible~~ physical impairment or morbidity of a major bodily

38 ~~(b) The physician certifies in writing that, in reasonable~~  
39 ~~medical judgment, there is a medical necessity for legitimate~~

42 ~~imminent substantial and irreversible physical impairment of a~~

46 ~~(b)-(c)~~ A physician determines ~~The pregnancy has not~~  
47 ~~progressed to the third trimester and two physicians certify in~~  
48 ~~writing~~ that, in reasonable medical judgment, the fetus has a  
49 fatal fetal abnormality.

50 ~~(c)-(d)~~ The pregnancy is the result of rape, incest, or

51 human trafficking and the gestational age of the fetus is not  
52 more than 15 weeks as determined by the physician. At the time  
53 the woman schedules or arrives for her appointment to obtain the  
54 abortion, she must provide a copy of a restraining order, police  
55 report, medical record, or other court order or documentation  
56 providing evidence that she is obtaining the termination of  
57 pregnancy because she is a victim of rape, incest, or human  
58 trafficking. If the woman is 18 years of age or older, the  
59 physician must report any known or suspected human trafficking  
60 to a local law enforcement agency. If the woman is a minor, the  
61 physician must report the incident of rape, incest, or human  
62 trafficking to the central abuse hotline as required by s.  
63 39.201.
