(4) (a) Every law enforcement agency and correctional 13 14 agency shall establish and put into operation a system for the 15 receipt, investigation, and determination of complaints received by such agency from any person, which must be the procedure for 16 17 investigating a complaint against a law enforcement or correctional officer and for determining whether to proceed with 18 19 disciplinary action or to file disciplinary charges, 20 notwithstanding any other law or ordinance to the contrary. A complaint may be submitted anonymously. However, such complaint 21 22 may not be investigated unless it is facially valid, meaning 23 that if the allegations in the complaint are taken as true, the 24 complaint would constitute grounds for discipline. A complaint 25 that is not facially valid may not become a part of a law 26 enforcement or correctional officer's record. Before a complaint 27 against a law enforcement or correctional officer is 28 investigated, the complaint must be made in writing and be 29 signed under oath pursuant to s. 92.525(2) by the person filing 30 the complaint or by another person who has knowledge of the 31 facts.
