Section 2. Funding for the construction, operation, and management of the museums may be funded by appropriations from the Legislature, which shall be limited to a period not to exceed 5 consecutive years and shall not exceed \$75 million.

Appropriations from the Legislature must be matched on a one-to-one basis with any combination of local government funding, grants, or philanthropic contributions.

Section 3. This act shall take effect July 1, 2025.
