470 **Section 2.** The Legislature finds that it is a public
471 necessity that the partial home addresses and telephone numbers
472 of current congressional members and public officers and their
473 spouses and adult children; the names, home addresses, telephone
474 numbers, and dates of birth of the minor children of such
475 congressional members and officers; and the names and locations
476 of schools and day care facilities attended by the minor
