Amendment (with title amendment)

Remove lines 167-173 and insert:

(3) All instructional materials, curriculum content, and programs funded in whole or in part with state or federal funds must be presented in a neutral, fact-based, nonadvocacy manner. Such materials or programs may not include explicit political messaging, calls to civic or political action, or the promotion or endorsement of a specific political ideology or partisan viewpoint. This subsection does not prohibit age-appropriate academic instruction on historical, cultural, scientific, or

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13 social topics, provided such instruction is grounded in
14 verifiable facts and established academic standards.

15 (4) Subsection (2) does not prohibit programs, campus
16 activities, or functions required for compliance with general or
17 federal laws or regulations; for obtaining or retaining
18 accreditation and for continuing to receive state funds with the
19 approval of either the State Board of Education or the
20 Department of Education.
