Remove everything after the enacting clause and insert:

**Section 1. Subsection (5) of section 121.031, Florida
Statutes, is amended to read:**

121.031 Administration of system; appropriation; oaths;
actuarial studies; public records.—

(5)(a) Personal identifying information of a member or
payee of the Florida Retirement System Pension Plan or any other
state-administered retirement system held by the division or the
state board, is ~~The names and addresses of retirees are
confidential and exempt from the provisions of s. 119.07(1) and
s. 24(a), Art. I of the State Constitution to the extent that no~~

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~~state or local governmental agency may provide the names or addresses of such persons in aggregate, compiled, or list form to any person except to a public agency engaged in official business. However, a state or local government agency may provide the names and addresses of retirees from that agency to a bargaining agent as defined in s. 447.203(12) or to a retiree organization for official business use. Lists of names or addresses of retirees may be exchanged by public agencies, but such lists shall not be provided to, or open for inspection by, the public. Any person may view or copy any individual's retirement records at the Department of Management Services, one record at a time, or may obtain information by a separate written request for a named individual for which information is desired.~~

(b) The public records exemption contained in this subsection applies to information held by the division before, on, or after July 1, 2026.

(c) This subsection is subject to the Open Government Sunset Review Act in accordance with s. 119.15 and shall stand repealed on October 2, 2031, unless reviewed and saved from repeal through reenactment by the Legislature.

Section 2. The Legislature finds that it is a public necessity that personal identifying information of a member or payee of the Florida Retirement System Pension Plan or any other state-administered retirement system held by the Division of

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42 Retirement within the Department of Management Services or the
43 State Board of Administration be made exempt from s. 119.07(1),
44 Florida Statutes, and s. 24(a), Art. I of the State
45 Constitution. The release of such personal identifying
46 information could allow predatory individuals and organizations
47 to target retirement plan members and payees for financial
48 exploitation or fraud. In addition, personal identifying
49 information of Florida Retirement System Investment Plan members
50 is already exempt from public records requirements and extending
51 similar protections promotes uniform treatment of personal
52 identifying information for all Florida Retirement System
53 members and payees. For these reasons, the Legislature finds
54 that it is a public necessity to exempt such information from
55 public records requirements.

56 **Section 3.** This act shall take effect July 1, 2026.
