 2 An act relating to consultant pharmacists; amending s.
 3 465.0125, F.S.; revising the definition of "health
 4 care facility"; authorizing consultant pharmacists to
 5 provide medication management services in clinics
 6 owned by a hospital or by one or more physicians who
 7 are employed by or contracted with a hospital;
 8 providing an effective date.

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 10 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

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 12 **Section 1. Paragraph (e) of subsection (1) of section**
 13 **465.0125, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:**

14 465.0125 Consultant pharmacist license; application,
 15 renewal, fees; responsibilities; rules.—

16 (1) The department shall issue or renew a consultant
 17 pharmacist license upon receipt of an initial or renewal
 18 application that conforms to the requirements for consultant
 19 pharmacist initial licensure or renewal as adopted by the board
 20 by rule and a fee set by the board not to exceed \$250. To be
 21 licensed as a consultant pharmacist, a pharmacist must complete
 22 additional training as required by the board.

23 (e) For purposes of this subsection, the term "health care
 24 facility" means an ambulatory surgical center or hospital
 25 licensed under chapter 395, an alcohol or chemical dependency

26 | treatment center licensed under chapter 397, an inpatient
27 | hospice licensed under part IV of chapter 400, a nursing home
28 | licensed under part II of chapter 400, an ambulatory care center
29 | as defined in s. 408.07, ~~or~~ a nursing home component under
30 | chapter 400 within a continuing care facility licensed under
31 | chapter 651, or a health care clinic that is owned by a hospital
32 | or by one or more physicians that are employed by or contracted
33 | with a hospital.
