An act relating to trade-in vehicle valuation; amending s. 681.102, F.S.; revising the definition of the term "purchase price" for purposes of the Motor Vehicle Warranty Enforcement Act; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Subsection (18) of section 681.102, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

681.102 Definitions.—As used in this chapter, the term:

(18) "Purchase price" means the cash price as defined in s. 520.31(2), inclusive of any allowance for a trade-in vehicle, but excludes debt from any other transaction. "Any allowance for a trade-in vehicle" means the net trade-in allowance as reflected in the purchase contract or lease agreement if acceptable to the consumer and manufacturer. If such amount is not acceptable to the consumer and manufacturer, then the trade-in allowance <u>must shall</u> be an amount equal to 100 percent of the retail price of the trade-in vehicle as reflected in <u>J.D. Power</u>, or the nearest valuation date listed for the trade-in vehicle by <u>J.D. Power</u> the NADA Official Used Car Guide (Southeastern Edition) or NADA Recreation Vehicle Appraisal Guide, whichever is applicable, in effect at the time of the trade-in. The manufacturer <u>is shall be</u> responsible for providing the applicable J.D. Power valuation NADA book.

Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2026.
