A bill to be entitled

An act relating to the Insurance Solutions Advisory Council; creating the advisory council within the Office of Insurance Regulation for specified purposes relating to data and information on the property and automobile insurance market; providing for membership of the advisory council; providing for per diem and travel expenses; providing for meetings of the advisory council; requiring the office to provide the advisory council with staffing and administrative assistance; requiring the advisory council to submit a specified report annually; providing for future legislative review and expiration of the advisory council; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

## Section 1. Insurance Solutions Advisory Council. -

(1) The Insurance Solutions Advisory Council, an advisory council as defined in s. 20.03(7), Florida Statutes, is created within the Office of Insurance Regulation to analyze and compile available data and evaluate relevant and applicable information relating to Florida's property and automobile insurance market. The advisory council shall serve in an advisory capacity to the office and the Legislature and, except as otherwise provided in

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this	section,	shall	comply	with	the	requirements	of	s.	20.052,

(2) The advisory council shall be composed of the following members:

- (a) Three members appointed by the Speaker of the House of Representatives:
- 1. One member representing a residential property and casualty insurer that has issued at least 150,000 homeowner's insurance policies in this state at the time of the creation of the advisory council.
  - 2. One member representing a surplus lines insurer.
  - 3. One member who is a trial attorney.
- (b) Three members appointed by the President of the Senate:
- 1. One member representing a commercial nonresidential property and casualty insurer.
- 2. One member representing a residential property and casualty insurer that has issued fewer than 150,000 homeowner's insurance policies in this state at the time of the creation of the advisory council.
  - 3. One member who is a public adjuster.
- (c) Three members appointed by the Governor who are not employed by or professionally affiliated with an insurance company or a subsidiary of an insurance company, at least one of whom must be a consumer advocate or a member of a consumer

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advocacy organization or agency and one of whom must be recommended by the Florida Insurance Council. The Governor shall appoint from among the three members the advisory council's chair.

- (d) Two members appointed by the Chief Financial Officer, representing insurance agents in this state.
- (e) One member representing Citizens Property Insurance
  Corporation, selected by the chair of the board of governors of
  the Citizens Property Insurance Corporation.
- (f) The Commissioner of Insurance Regulation or his or her designee.
- (3) Members must be appointed no later than August 1, 2026. Members serve at the pleasure of the officer who appointed them, and a vacancy on the advisory council must be filled in the same manner as the original appointment. Members of the advisory council shall serve without compensation but are entitled to reimbursement for per diem and travel expenses pursuant to s. 112.061, Florida Statutes.
- (4) The advisory council shall meet at the call of the chair at a time and location in this state designated by the chair.
- (5) The Office of Insurance Regulation shall provide staffing and administrative assistance to the advisory council in performing its duties.
  - (6) Beginning October 1, 2026, the advisory council shall

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(7) In accordance with s. 20.052(8), Florida Statutes, this section is repealed October 2, 2029, unless reviewed and saved from repeal through reenactment by the Legislature.

Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2026.

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
