2 An act relating to concurrent legislative jurisdiction
3 over United States military installations; creating s.
4 250.031, F.S.; providing that this state has
5 concurrent legislative jurisdiction with the United
6 States over United States military installations
7 located within the boundaries of this state; providing
8 procedures and requirements therefor; providing an
9 effective date.

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11 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

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13 **Section 1. Section 250.031, Florida Statutes, is created**
14 **to read:**

15 250.031 United States military installations; concurrent
16 legislative jurisdiction.—

17 (1) This state accepts the relinquishment of exclusive
18 legislative jurisdiction from the United States in accordance
19 with this section.

20 (2) This state has concurrent legislative jurisdiction
21 with the United States over any United States military
22 installation under the control of the United States which is
23 located within the boundaries of this state.

24 (3) The concurrent legislative jurisdiction over a United
25 States military installation under this section is effective

26 upon the Governor's written acceptance of a request filed with
27 the Secretary of State by the principal officer, or other
28 authorized representative who has supervision or control over
29 the military installation under 10 U.S.C. s. 2683, of the
30 military installation where concurrent legislative jurisdiction
31 is sought, relinquishing exclusive legislative jurisdiction and
32 retaining concurrent legislative jurisdiction over the military
33 installation.

34 (4) The Governor may not accept a request filed under
35 subsection (3) unless the request:

36 (a) States the name, position, and legal authority of the
37 individual requesting the cession.

38 (b) Unambiguously states the subject matter for the
39 concurrent legislative jurisdiction request.

40 (c) Describes by metes and bounds the United States
41 military installation subject to the concurrent legislative
42 jurisdiction request.

43 (d) Indicates whether the concurrent legislative
44 jurisdiction request includes future contiguous expansions of
45 land acquired for military purposes.

46 (5) If the Governor accepts a request filed under
47 subsection (3):

48 (a) The Governor's acceptance must state each element of
49 the concurrent legislative jurisdiction request which is
50 accepted.

51 (b) The Governor shall submit the following documents to
52 the appropriate recording office for indexing and submit copies
53 of the following documents to the individual who filed the
54 request for concurrent legislative jurisdiction:

55 1. The request for concurrent legislative jurisdiction.

56 2. The Governor's written acceptance of concurrent
57 legislative jurisdiction.

58 3. A description by metes and bounds of the United States
59 military installation subject to the concurrent legislative
60 jurisdiction.

61 (6) Upon request by the United States through an
62 authorized representative, the Governor is authorized to execute
63 appropriate documents to accomplish the cession granted by this
64 section.

65 (7) Upon establishment of concurrent legislative
66 jurisdiction under this section, a state agency, local
67 government, or special district may enter a reciprocal agreement
68 with a United States agency to designate duties related to the
69 concurrent legislative jurisdiction between the parties.

70 **Section 2.** This act shall take effect July 1, 2026.
